SOUTH SOMERSET ORDER 2012  
(AMENDMENT NO.34) ORDER 2025**

Notice is hereby given that Somerset Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 2004') as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect will result in changes to the parking and waiting restrictions in the following location:

**Milborne Port:** A30 High Street.

**Yeovil:** A30 Queensway, Larkhill Road, Middle Street, Newton Road, Milford Road, Chelston Avenue, St Mary's Crescent, Stratford Road, Preston Road, Vale Road.

**Bruton:** A359 High Street, B3081 Station Road, Mill Lane, Lower Backway.

**Wincanton:** B3081 Market Place.

**Somerton:** B3153 Pound Pool, St Cleer's Orchard.

**Odcombe:** Broadway, Ham Hill Road.

**East Chinnock:** College, A30 High Street, Weston Street.

**Stoford:** Meadow View, Newton Road.

**Yeovil Without:** Birchfield School Road, Stone Lane, Combe Street Lane, Mudford Road.

**Crewkerne:** Orchard Rise, Furland Road.

**Chard:** Hartsfield, Forton Road.

**Misterton:** A356 Station Road, Silver Street.

**Tintinhull:** School Close, Vicarage Street.

**Curry Rivel:** Westover Trading Estate.

**Castle Cary:** The Pitchings, Victoria Court, Victoria Road.
