ITEM	DESCRIPTION
Membership	Number of Members: 6-12, including 1-3 town councillors, at least one One Planet Bruton representative and other members of the community.
Chair	To be selected by the members.
Frequency of meetings	To meet at least quarterly.
Open to press & public	Yes (unless a Resolution is made to exclude the press and public for a specific item / specific reason). Open to all people who live, work, or attend school in the Parish of Bruton, or its adjoining Parishes.
Quorum	Three (including at least one town councillor and one non-town councillor).
Purpose and Scope	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To advise the Town Council on implementation of the 'Climate and Ecological Emergency' declared in March 2019 • To advise the Town Council on adoption of Bioregional's One Planet Living framework (adopted by Bruton Town Council as the sustainability vision for the town: One Planet Bruton). • Scope: "To do everything within the Town Council's power to make Bruton carbon neutral by 2030". To monitor progress made by Bruton Town Council against the recommendations made by the Climate and Ecological Emergency Working Group.
Reports to	This working group will report directly to Full Council.
